Call for Expression of Interest for Choral Canada's National Youth Choir of Canada Committee member positions

Choral Canada is the National Arts Service Organization for the choral arts sector and community in Canada. The organization exists to provide programs and services tailored towards professional development, advocacy, resources, celebrating choral music, and building connections across this vast country. One of Choral Canada's flagship programs is the National Youth Choir of Canada (NYCC). It is a one-of-a-kind professional development opportunity for some of Canada's top emerging choral singers.

Choral Canada is seeking two (2) individuals to join the NYCC Committee. The committee is responsible for supporting the Choral Canada staff in preparing policy, in planning and executing the program, and fundraising and promoting the NYCC program. We are seeking two individuals who are passionate and knowledgeable about group singing/choral music and the NYCC in particular. They are collaborative team players with excellent interpersonal and listening skills.

The membership of the NYCC Committee will be comprised of individuals who represent differences in human qualities and characteristics. We value new perspectives and original ideas. We strongly encourage members from the Indigenous, Black, racialized, LGBTQ2S+, persons with disability, refugee and newcomer communities to apply for the positions.

Language

The working language of the committee is English, but bilingualism in both English and French is an asset.

Accessibility, diversity, equity, and inclusion

Choral Canada is committed to inclusion, diversity, equity, and accessibility in all its work, and to being fair and equitable in practice. It strives to build diversity and inclusivity into its teams, committees, programs, and services, thereby fostering an organizational environment in which all people wishing to participate may flourish.

Selection and Length of Term

The Chair of the NYCC Committee will select the two members of the committee. Selection will be based upon the candidate's expression of interest and the qualifications outlined above. All individuals who express interest in the positions will be contacted directly regarding the outcome of the process. Members' terms are for two years, and can be renewed for up to three consecutive terms, at the discretion of the Chair.
